FORMER RESIDENT DIES AT COLUMBUS

Mrs. Emma Bunchue Krupp, wife of Charles W. Krupp, of Norwalk, formerly of this city, died Sunday evening at 4:30 o'clock at St. Anthony's hospital, Columbus, after an illness of many months with tuberculosis.

She was born at Willard and was married in this city, 16 years ago to Charles W. Krupp, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Krupp, of 86 Melmore street. Her husband, three children, Viola, 13 years, Myron, 11 years, and John, 9 years and one brother, Edward Bunchue, of this city, survive her.

Her funeral will be held at the home, 12 Rule street, Norwalk, Wednesday morning at 10 o'clock, and will be private because no public church funeral are permitted there. Burial will be made at St. Paul's cemetery, Norwalk, beside her mother.
