# WORLD WAR VETERAN DIES AT AGE OF 34

## Floyd Krupp Succumbed Last Night At Home Of His Par- ents, Here

Floyd L. Krupp, 34, field artillery man during the world war, died Tuesday evening in the home of his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Lewis Krupp, 171 Fourth avenue. Death was due to tuberculosis.

He was born in Republic, Jan. 25, 1895. During the world war he was a member of the 135th field artillery of the 37th division. He served overseas for one year.

Besides his parents he leaves a sister and four brothers: Mrs. Charles Birch, Jesse, DeForest, Alvin and Orlin Krupp, all of Tiffin.

Mr. Krupp was a member of the Methodist Protestant church.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock in the home, conducted by the Rev. E. H. Hawkins. Interment will be in Fairmount cemetery.
