

Harvey V. Krupp

Harvey V. Krupp, 76, of 20 First Ave., died suddenly at 2:30 a.m. today, Dec. 15, 1971, in Tiffin Mercy Hospital, where he had been admitted Monday.

He was a retired maintenance department employe of Tiffin State Hospital and a member of First Lutheran Church and the American Legion. He was a veteran of World War I.

He was born April 14, 1895, in Thompson, Ohio, to Joseph and Anna (Hepp) Krupp. He had lived in Tiffin 48 years, coming here from Toledo. He married Helen C. Courtney on Sept. 1, 1917, in Toledo.

Survivors include his wife; two sons, Harvey V. Krupp Jr., of Menomonee Falls, Wis., and William M. Krupp of Orchard Park, N.Y.; a daughter, Mrs. John (Carol) Cleveland of Tiffin; a brother, Ernest Krupp of Attica; and 13 grandchildren.
