

## DEATH CLAIMS WIFE OF A WELL KNOWN CITIZEN

**Mrs. Charles J. Krupp Passes Away at  
Family Home on Wayne Street.**

After an illness of several years, Mrs. Charles J. Krupp passed away at the family residence, 404 Wayne street, Monday morning at 3:15 o'clock.

The end, which was not unexpected, was none the less a shock to devoted friends. Mrs. Krupp had been in poor health for five years and many eminent specialists had been consulted.

She was married to Mr. Krupp in November, 1878, and her husband and two children, Mrs. Thomas A. Hicks, of Catusauqua, Pa., and Ira C. J. Krupp, of this city, survive her.

The funeral will be held from the residence, Thursday morning at 8 o'clock, followed by a solemn high requiem mass at Sts. Peter and Paul's church at 8:20. Rev. Father Murphy will officiate, assisted by other clergymen.
