DEAD IN TOLEDO

Rites to be Friday for Tiffin

Mrs. Irene A. (Harnish) Krupp, 70, of 1105 Sherman street, Toledo, native of Tiffin, died Tuesday, Nov. 14, 1961 in St. Vincent's hospital in Toledo. She had been seriously ill for a week.

A resident of Toledo for the last 32 years, Mrs. Krupp was born in Tiffin Feb. 15, 1891 to Peter and Anna (Clay) Harnish. She was married 53 years ago to Louis J. Krupp, and is survived by her husband, a daughter, Mrs. Marcus Cantrell, Toledo, a sister Mrs. Olive Kapp, Fontana, Cal.; and a brother, Warner Harnish, Tiffin.
