

JOHN KRUPP, 81, DIES SUDDENLY IN TOLEDO

Funeral Here Saturday for Former Resident

John Krupp, 81, formerly of Tiffin, died suddenly Thursday morning at two o'clock at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Charles Shultz of Toledo, according to information received here by friends. He left Tiffin three years ago.

His body will be brought to this city Friday, and will be taken to the home of his son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Leonard Breidenbach, 281 Circular street. Funeral services will be held Saturday morning at nine o'clock in St. Joseph's church. Burial will be in the parish cemetery.
