

MRS. JOHN KRUPP, 80, ILL ONLY WEEK, DIES

Services For Life Long Resident of County To Be Held Wednesday

Mrs. Margaret Krupp, 80, life-long resident of Seneca county and wife of John Krupp, died Sunday morning at 4 o'clock in her residence at 71 1/2 East Market street.

Death was due to bronchial pneumonia, brought on following an attack of the grippe. She had been ill only a week.

Mrs. Krupp was born June 27, 1847, in Liberty township and was a daughter of Nicholas and Anna Marie (Brickner) Smith. She came to Tiffin at the age of 19. She was married to Mr. Krupp Jan. 12, 1875. Three years ago they celebrated their golden wedding anniversary.

She is survived by her husband and seven children: Charles W. Krupp of Norwalk, Albert J. Krupp of Toledo, Otto A. Krupp of Cambridge, Louis J. Krupp of Tiffin, Mrs. Charles Shultz of Toledo, Mrs. Albert Shultz of Mansfield and Mrs. Leonard Brendenbach of Tiffin.

Twenty-one grandchildren, three great grandchildren and a brother and sister, Nicholas Smith and Mrs. John Lorentz of Tiffin, also survive.

Mrs. Krupp was a life-long member of St. Joseph's church and the Poor Soul's society of the church.

Funeral services will be held in St. Joseph's church Wednesday morning at 9 o'clock. Burial will be in the parish cemetery.
