Paul P. Krupp, 74, of 151 Muncie street, Carey, died at 8:40 p.m. Monday in Mercy hospital, Toledo. He had been seriously ill for 10 days, and death is attributed to leukemia.

Born in Reed township May 6, 1890, to Peter and Elizabeth (Ruffing) Krupp, he married Eunice Courtad Nov. 5, 1919, and she died Sept. 3, 1939. He married Mrs. Martha Schreiner on June 1, 1940, and she survives, with a daughter, Catherine, at home, five step-children, Howard and Melvin S. Schreiner, both of Postoria; Herman Schreiner, West Millgrove; Eugene S. Schreiner, Adrian; and Mrs. James (Marie) Smith, Carey; 25 grandchildren; a brother, Vincent Krupp, Carey; and two sisters, Mrs. Esther Kelbley, Westerville; and Mrs. Loretta Lewis, Akron. A sister and five brothers are deceased.
