LORAIN — Longtime Lorain resident Mrs. Thelma P. Krupp, 75, died yesterday at St. Joseph Hospital after a one-year illness.

Surviving are sons Jack and James, both of Lorain; and two grandchildren. Her husband, Chalmers, died in 1958.
