

MRS. MARY HOSMAN DIES AT HOSPITAL

Funeral Services Thurs- day in Reed

Mrs. Mary Veronica Hosman, 85, widow of Henry J. Hosman, lifelong resident of Reed township, died at 6:40 p. m. Monday, May 2, 1949, in Mercy hospital. She had been bed-fast for the last three months, and four weeks ago she was taken to the hospital from the home of her son Edward. She had been in frail health for two years and had made her home among her children since the death of her husband three years ago.

Mrs. Hosman was the daughter of John and Frances (Koby) Schriener, and was the eldest daughter in a family of 10. She was the mother of eight. The two oldest daughters died in childhood, and the following son and five daughters survive, Edward Hosman, and Cora, wife of Earl Crist, of this city; Mrs. Anna Gerber, Sandusky; Mrs. Gertrude Schoen, and Theresa, wife of Albert Hahl, both of Reed; and Rose, wife of Frank Roth, of Fostoria. She has 22 grandchildren and 21 great-grandchildren; two sisters and two brothers, Mrs. August Zurcher, and Mrs. Lena Grosswiler, both of Bellevue; Charles Schriener, Reed; and Anthony Schriener, Tiffin.

She was born in Reed township March 20, 1864, and was a lifelong member of Assumption Catholic Church where she was married May 4, 1886. She and Mr. Hosman celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary a month before his death in 1946. She was a member of the Altar Society.

Services will be held at 9:30 a. m. Thursday in Assumption Church with the Rev. Francis Krull officiating. Burial will be in the adjoining cemetery. Friends may call after 7 p. m. at the Hoffmann Memorial.
