# AGNES SCHREINER FUNERAL MONDAY

New Riegel Resident Hit by  
Lightning June 24

Mrs. Agnes C. Schreiner, 48, wife of Earl Schreiner of rural route 1, New Riegel, died in Mercy hospital at 8:20 p.m. Thursday, August 20, 1959, from the effects of a bolt of lightning which struck her at their farm on June 24.

Mrs. Schreiner, who was partially paralyzed by the bolt, had been in Mercy hospital here and in St. Vincent's hospital, Toledo, since the accident.

She was born at Alvada June 23, 1911, to Louis and Sarah (Kirian) Gillig, and was married in St. Peter's church, Alvada, in January of 1935 to Earl Schreiner.

Mrs. Schreiner was a lifelong resident of the Alvada and New Riegel community and was a member of St. Boniface Catholic church in New Riegel.

Surviving with the husband are three sons, Orland Schreiner of Tiffin and Arthur and Leonard Schreiner at home; two daughters, Shirley, wife of Richard Hammer of Fremont and Rosemary, wife of Harland Arbogast of Frenchtown; six brothers, Raymond and Herman Gillig of Tiffin, Earl and Clarence Gillig of Fostoria, Joseph Gillig of Alvada and Elmer Gillig of New Riegel; two sisters, Miss Irene Gillig of Toledo and Mrs. Mary Reinhart of Fostoria and one grandchild.

Funeral services will be conducted in St. Boniface Catholic church at New Riegel at 9:30 a.m. Monday and will be followed by burial in the parish cemetery.
