SCHREINER—At his home, 114 East Perry street, Feb. 10, 1904, at 11:15 o'clock, this morning Andrew Schreiner, aged 65 years.

The deceased was born in Allentown, Pa., Nov 5, 1839. In Adrian, Mich., Dec. 21, 1865, he was married to Miss Sarah Dick, and to this union were born four children, his wife dying May 11, 1887. On January 1, 1890, Mr. Schreiner married Miss Belle Fleming of this city, who survives him with the following children: Mrs. Charles Huber, William, both of Cleveland, Olara and Nellie of this city.

Mr. Schreiner was a member of Co. A, 8th O. V. I. during the civil war and was a prominent member of Gibson Post, G. A. R. For many years he was undertaker in the furniture establishment of the late Henry Fiege and held this position until about six years ago when he was incapacitated by a stroke of paralysis from which he has suffered more or less ever since.

The funeral will be held at the First Reformed church at 2 p. m., Friday.
