

HARDWARE-STORE SALESMAN DIES

Services To Be Wednesday For Anthony Schreiner

Anthony (Tony) Schreiner, 74, of 122 Circular street, died at 2:55 a. m. Sunday, April 6, 1952, in Mercy hospital, following three months of illness.

A resident of Tiffin 33 years, he was employed as a clerk in the Schwable hardware store here. He formerly operated a restaurant in Republic for many years. A lifelong resident of this area, he was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic church and the Holy Name society.
