

FRANK SCHREINER DIED AT HAMILTON

Frank Schreiner, son of Antonia and Karl Schreiner, died early this morning at Hamilton, after a week's illness following an attack of influenza.

His parents received the first word of his condition on Wednesday evening, on Friday a message came announcing that his condition was dangerous. His father, mother and sister, Mary, left at once for Hamilton. He appeared to be improving and on Saturday his father and sister returned. This morning they received word of his death.

He was born in Germany, in March, 1892, and was but five months old when he was brought to this country. His parents came to this city where he lived until a few years ago. For many years he acted as assistant to Charles Pahl and after leaving the profession he went to Hamilton where he was in business for himself. That was two or three years ago. Two years ago he was united in marriage to Miss Lillian Schreck who survives his as does one son, Frank, Jr., aged five months. The remains will be sent to this city as soon as possible, the funeral arrangements will be announced later.
