

FRANK R. SCHREINER PNEUMONIA VICTIM

Prominent Undertaker of Hamilton and Formerly of Tiffin Dies Suddenly

Frank Schreiner, a former Tiffin resident, died Monday morning at 6 o'clock, at his home in Hamilton, where he had been engaged in the undertaking business, since February, 1916. He had been ill with influenza and pneumonia for several days. The deceased was aged 27 years. He was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Carl Schreiner, of 112 Hancock street and was employed for several years by Charles Fahie, Tiffin undertaker, until he engaged in the business for himself at Hamilton.

Mr. Schreiner was married November 30, 1916, to Miss Lillian Schreck, of Hamilton, who survives him as does also one child, five months old. He is also survived by his parents and one sister, Miss Mary Schreiner, of this city. The body will probably be brought to Tiffin for interment.
