Sketch of the Life of John Schreiner, Who Died Sunday Afternoon.

Reed, April 18.—John Schreiner, aged 70 years, 6 months, 4 days, died at his home in Reed, Sunday afternoon about one o'clock. Death was due to a peculiar disease of the stomach, from which he had been suffering for months, and his recovery was not anticipated.

Mr. Schreiner was born in Germany, November 11, 1834. In his nineteenth year he came to America and made his home in the vicinity of Reed. His two sisters died some years ago, but his brother Michael still lives in Thompson. In 1856 he was married to Frances Koby, and eleven children, one of which died in infancy, were born unto them. Micheal the oldest of the family, lives in Thompson; Martin, in Sherman; Mary Hossman, in Reed; Josaphine, wife of Paul Herter, resides in Mequoketa, Iowa; Catharine Schoenacker in Peru, and Anthony in Republic. Lena, Charles, and Andrew, are at home with their mother. Besides his wife and children, thirteen grandchildren mourn his death.

Mr. Schreiner was well known in Seneca county and his many friends extend their kind sympathy to the bereaved family. The funeral took place in

the Reed church at 8:30, Wednesday, and the remains were interred in the Catholic cemetery. Rev. C. Vogelmann officiated.
