

# Joseph J. Schreiner

Joseph J. Schreiner, 56, was found dead about 4:30 p.m. Monday, July 24, 1972, in his home at the corner of River Road and Center Road.

Dr. O. G. Burkart, Seneca County Coroner, ruled that death was due to natural causes and probably had occurred either Saturday or Sunday. Mr. Schreiner had been afflicted with asthma and emphysema.

He was born Dec. 26, 1915, in Defiance to Frank and Kathrine Schreiner. He married Genevieve Schreiner on Sept. 4, 1936, in St. Boniface Catholic Church in New Riegel, and she survives.

Also surviving are three sons, Joseph Jr. and Gerald, both of Tiffin, and Richard of route 2, Tiffin; a daughter, Mrs. Laurent (Elizabeth) Brickner, route 4; and nine grandchildren. He was preceded in death by a son, Robert, and a brother, John.

Mr. Schreiner was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church and Tiffin Eagles Lodge. A driver with Yellow Transit Lines, he was a member of the Fraternal Order of Steel Haulers.

Service will be conducted at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday in St. Joseph Church and will be followed by burial in the parish cemetery.

The body is in the Pahl - Nemeth Funeral Home, where friends may call from 3-5 and 7-9 o'clock today. The casket will remain closed.
