Leonard J. Schreiner, 78, of 581 Maple St., Fostoria, died Friday morning, June 22, 1973, in Tiffin.

Born Jan. 9, 1895, in Carrothers, he was a son of Peter and Susan (Thiry) Schreiner. He married Marie Faber June 2, 1920, in Fostoria.
