

# Louis A. Schreiner

Louis A. Schreiner, 57, of 190 Circular street, died at 12:25 p.m. Monday, May 18, 1970, in St. Joseph Mercy hospital, Ann Arbor, Mich., where he had been a patient for past three months. His death was caused by lymphoma.

He was born March 2, 1913, in Tiffin to Louis and Rose (Kuhn) Schreiner. He was married Sept. 2, 1946, in St. Wendelin's Catholic church in Fostoria to Virginia S. Bangert, who survives.
