

LONG-TIME RESIDENT OF THOMPSON TWP. DIED ON SATURDAY

**FUNERAL SERVICES FOR MICHAEL
SCHREINER WILL BE CONDUCT-
ED TUESDAY.**

Funeral services for a practically life-long resident of Thompson township and widely known and respected resident of the Frank vicinity will be conducted Tuesday morning, when obsequies are held for Michael Schreiner, 77, whose death occurred Saturday evening at 5:30 o'clock, culminating a year's illness.

Mr. Schreiner was born August 15, 1857, in Thompson township, and had spent practically his entire life in the area directly south of Bellevue. He was a son of John and Frances Schreiner, and had devoted his life to farming.

The deceased was twice married, having been united in marriage with Helena Schaub, whose death occurred in 1883, and subsequently was married to Helena Sickenger, who preceded him in death in 1925.

Surviving are one son, J. A. Schreiner, Frank; three brothers, Anthony, of Tiffin, Charles of Reed, and Andrew of Norwalk, and four sisters, Mrs. Mary Hossman, Reed; Mrs. Lena Roseweiler, Norwalk; Mrs. Josephine Heter, residing in Missouri, and Mrs. Rose Zurcher, Bellevue. One brother and one sister preceded him in death.

Rev. C. N. Faist will officiate Tuesday morning when funeral rites are conducted at 9:30 o'clock in St. Michael's Catholic church at Frank, and burial will be in the Catholic cemetery in Bellevue. Funeral arrangements are in charge of the Atherton Funeral Home.
