

## Urban Schreiner

Urban E. Schreiner, 78, formerly of 139 Melmore St., died at 12:31 a.m. today, March 3, 1976, in the home of his daughter at 422 Circular St., where he had made his home for the past year.

He was born Sept. 5, 1897, in Seneca County to Louis and Rose (Kuhn) Schreiner. He married Lucille H. Smith in St. Joseph Church on June 17, 1924, and she died March 26, 1970.
