# SCHRINER'S BODY IS RECOVERED

About 2 o'clock this afternoon the body of Cornelius Schriener was found near the residence of Frank Stamm, on the old Kibble farm. This is not far distant from Schriener's own home, and the spot where he was drowned. The remains were taken to the home of Mr. Stamm. Martin's undertaking wagon was called and the body is being removed to the deceased's late home.

Dr. Stevens gained the true story of the drowning from Mrs. Schriener. She says they had gone over a different road home than they took coming into the city. That if the

other road had been taken, the accident would not have happened. When the rig went off into the water both Mr. and Mrs. Schriener got onto the backs of the horses. In this manner, Mrs. Schriener was carried to the bank where she clung to some bushes. Mr. Schriener would also have been saved, but the horse which he was riding got entangled in a barbed wire and became frightened. During the struggles of the horse Mr. Schriener was thrown from the animal, and as he fell, the horse kicked him. At this he called to his wife to try and save herself. This was the last seen of him by Mrs. Schriener. The latter is still in a precarious condition, but Dr. Stevens thinks she will recover.
