

FUNERAL THURSDAY FOR F. J. SCHRINER

Reed Township Farmer Died Early Today

Fred J. Schriener, 60, prominent Reed township farmer, died at 1:30 a.m. today, June 9, 1947, in Willard Municipal hospital. He had been ill for two years and in a critical condition for the last three weeks. His death is attributed to coronary occlusion.

Mr. Schriener was born Mar. 7, 1887 to Alois and Mary (Miller) Schriener. He was married to Nora Myers and her death occurred Sept. 7, 1944. His only immediate surviving relative is a sister, Celia, of Reed township.

Funeral services will be held at 9:30 a.m. Thursday in Reed Assumption Catholic church of which he was a member and will be conducted by the Rev. Fr. Krull. Burial will be made in the adjacent cemetery. The body will be removed from the Pancoast funeral home at Republic Tuesday evening to the family residence where friends may call.
