

Dr. Robert E. Schriner

Dr. Robert E. Schriner, 67, who resided on N. Plank Rd. (Route 53), died at 1 a.m. today, Jan. 21, 1971, in Tiffin Mercy Hospital. He had practiced medicine in Tiffin since November 1937, and maintained an office at 111 Madison St. He had been a patient in the hospital since 7 a.m. Wednesday.

The son of John and Bertha (McClintock) Schriner, he was born Feb. 14, 1903, in Fairfield County, Ohio. He married Mary F. Creed on Aug. 10, 1935, in Richmond, Ind. She and a sister, Mrs. Walter Stapf of Bellevue, are his only survivors.

Dr. Schriner graduated from Ohio State University in the spring of 1937. He was a member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church, Seneca County, Ohio State and American Medical Associations, Mohawk Golf Club, Catawba Island Club, Tiffin Elks lodge and several Masonic bodies, including F&AM Lodge, Scottish Rite, Aladin Shrine and Knights Templar.

The body is in the Hoffmann Memorial, where friends may call from 2 to 5 and 7 to 9 o'clock Friday. Elks memorial services will be held there at 8 p.m. Friday.

Funeral services, conducted by the Rev. Leland Wiley and the Rev. H. Joe Grimm, will be at 10 a.m. Saturday in the Hoffmann Memorial. Graveside services will be held at 2 p.m. that day in Forrest Rose Cemetery, Lancaster, Ohio.
